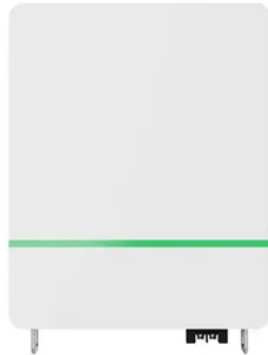


# Abuja emergency energy storage power supply
