

Cambodia power generation and energy storage



Overview

These initiatives include 12 solar power plants, six wind farms, a combined biomass and solar facility, an LNG power generation plant, a hydropower project, and two energy storage stations. The Government of Cambodia set a goal of electrifying all villages by 2020 and connecting at least 90 percent of all households to grid-quality electricity by 2030. At the end of 2024, 120 villages, or 0.85 percent of the total villages remain to be electrified due to geographical difficulties, and. Total energy supply (TES) includes all the energy produced in or imported to a country, minus that which is exported or stored. It represents all the energy required to supply end users in the country. However, another ongoing study has been conducted by JICA, Development of Clean Energy Transition Roadmap towards Carbon Neutral Society. The projects include 12 solar power plants.
