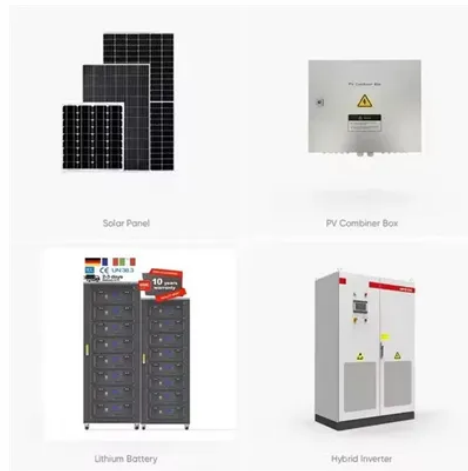


Copenhagen wind power system
