ESA deploys large-scale BESS to help stabilise national grids, enable renewable firming, and provide clean, low-cost peak power. We are currently developing projects in Malawi (60MW/240MWh) and Kenya (120MW/480MWh), with a broader development pipeline across Sub-Saharan Africa. East Africa is rapidly emerging as a hotspot for energy storage projects, driven by growing electricity demand and the need to stabilize renewable energy grids. Countries like Kenya, Tanzania, Ethiopia, and Uganda are leading the charge, with both grid-scale and decentralized solutions gaining.
