

Emergency power storage charging in ireland



Overview

The Irish Government's Climate Action Plan 2021 set out the need for an energy storage policy for Ireland to support 75% reduction in power sector CO2 emissions by 2030. There are 10 key policy actions in the framework outlining the timings and key stakeholders involved in. EirGrid, SONI, and SEMO have launched a major update to the electricity grid's Scheduling and Dispatch system, paving the way for large-scale battery storage to play a bigger role in balancing power across the island. The update, known as Initiative 2 of the Scheduling and Dispatch Programme. This is the first national policy for energy storage in Ireland and as called out by Eamon Ryan, Minister for the Environment, Climate and Communications – “it is vital that Ireland exploits the full potential of electricity storage, and the publication of this policy framework is an important step. At Energy Storage Ireland 2025, the message was clear: energy storage is central to a stable, low-carbon grid, and while short-duration battery systems (BESS) are available, long-duration storage (LDES) supply is in its infancy, however ESNB has a structure to enable LDES rollout in Ireland.
