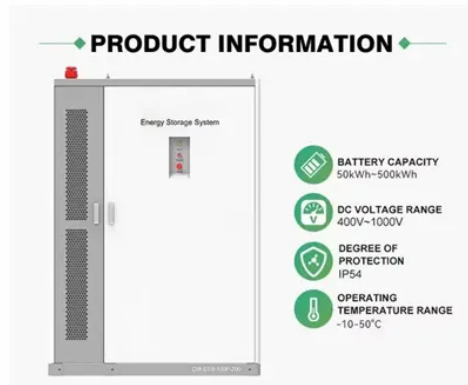


How many watts of solar energy are installed in bhutan



Overview

As per the Renewable Energy Management Master Plan 2016, it is estimated that Bhutan has the potential to produce 12 gigawatts of solar and 760 megawatts of wind energy. Solar electricity capacity includes solar photovoltaic and solar thermal capacity, and distributed solar capacity where available. It is spread across 44 acres of land and fitted with around 26,500 solar panels. Once fully operational, it will have the capacity to generate up to 22.38 megawatt-peak (MWp) of electricity. This capacity will help meet domestic energy demand, especially during winter months when Bhutan's. Bhutan Solar Initiative Project (BSIP) set up under Royal Command has implemented two Solar PV Projects in Thimphu. 250kW Rooftop Centenary Farmers Market (CMF) and 500kW Ground mounted at Dechencholing. This landmark initiative positions solar power as a vital step toward achieving energy self-sufficiency by 2025, a goal that aligns with the kingdom's.
