Overview

This initiative is part of a broader national strategy to modernize its aging grid and involves installing rooftop solar panel systems and battery energy storage systems (BESS) on 131 homes in the southern Batken-New Town, with plans to expand to other regions. In a significant move towards sustainable energy, Kyrgyzstan has launched a pilot project focusing on energy storage, funded by the Global Environment Facility and implemented by the UN Development Programme.
