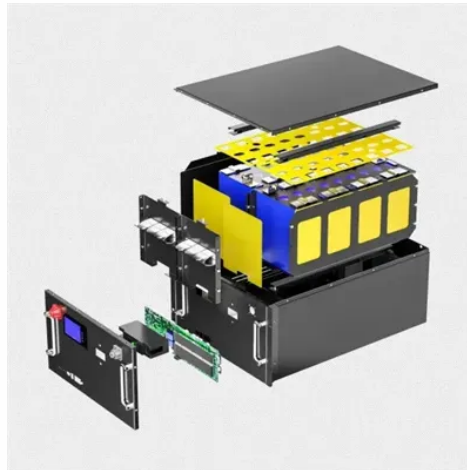


Large-scale financing plan for mobile outdoor cabinets in Kyrgyzstan
