How many solar power plants are there in Zambia?

It has implemented twoutility-scale solar power plants (54 megawatts and 34 megawatts) in Lusaka south multi-facility economic zone under the World Bank Scaling Solar initiative. However, about half of the Zambian population lives in rural areas. According to the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) □Global Status Report on Renewable Energy 2022□, Africa's off-grid solar product sales reached 7. 4 million units in 2021, making it the largest market globally.
