Overview

The compound annual growth rate (CAGR) was 5. From 2015 to 2020, capacity was stagnant at around 2.1 GW before climbing again in 2024. In 2024, Nigeria continued to rely heavily on energy storage imports, with significant shipments coming from China, India, Sweden, Vietnam, and Germany. In particular, the popularity of solar photovoltaics (PV) combined with batteries has skyrocketed. This represents a 76% increase over the decade. However, the country's rapid economic growth has outpaced its fragile power grid, resulting in frequent blackouts.
