Due to go online in December 2024 at a site in Samcheok, it will be a 2,000kWdc/11,600kWhdc NAS. The Yeongdong PSH Plant, with a total capacity of 500 MW (250 MW x 2 units), is scheduled to be built in Yeongdong County, North Chungcheong Province, by 2030.
