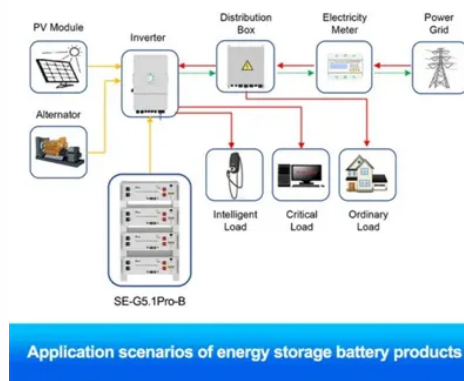

It will be equipped with a total of around 70,000 solar panels.
