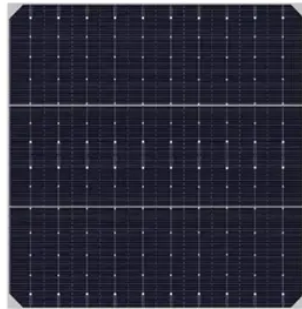


Romania 2025 energy storage projects
