This is where the bus bar comes in. They quietly manage high currents, reduce wiring clutter, and ensure safe, efficient power distribution throughout the system. But what exactly is a busbar, why is it so important, and when should you use one?

Then it dawned on me, why not connect each battery individually to a bus bar?

Then connect that bus bar to another that is attached to shore power, MPPT, inverter, and a fuse block. Connecting the solar charge controller, inverter, and battery to a bus bar is generally acceptable, as it distributes electrical power efficiently and effectively.
