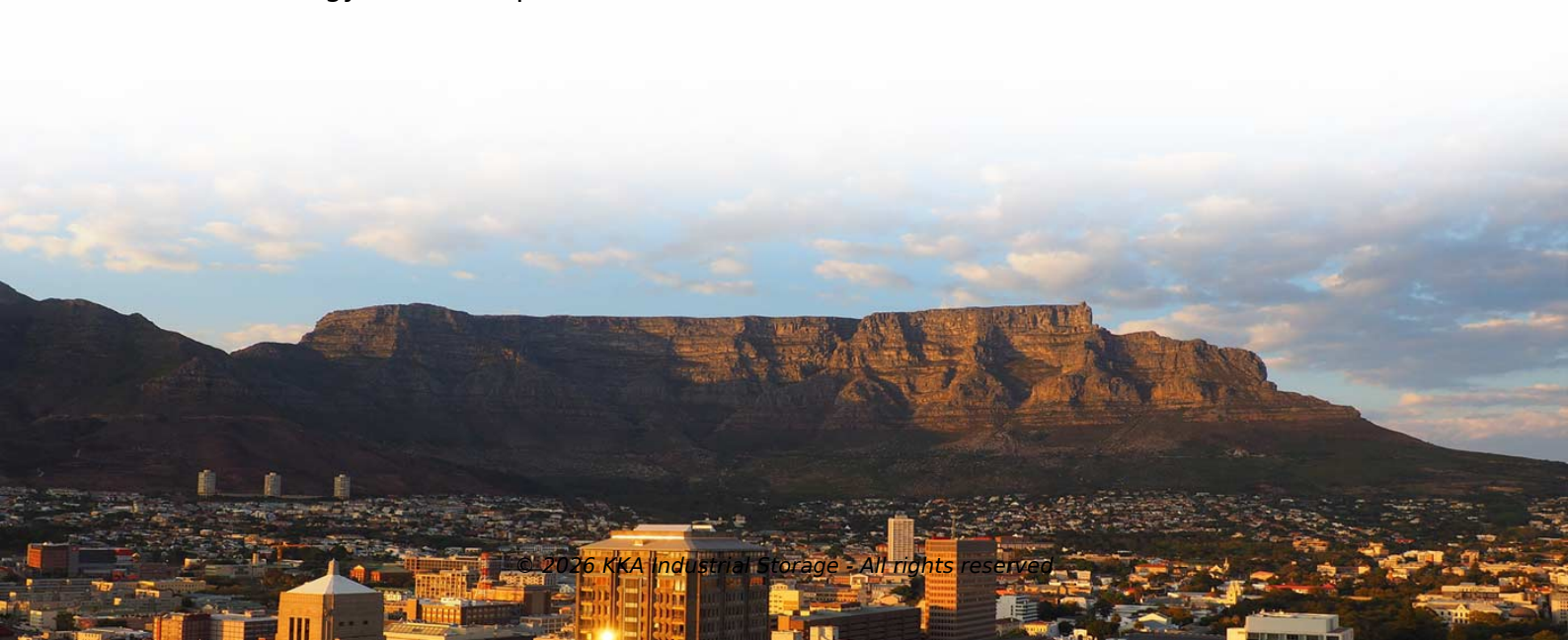


Spacing between energy storage cabinet and other equipment



Overview

5 of NFPA 855, we learn that individual ESS units shall be separated from each other by a minimum of three feet unless smaller separation distances are documented to be adequate and approved by the authority having jurisdiction (AHJ) based on large-scale fire testing. NFPA 855 sets the rules in residential settings for each energy storage unit—how many kWh you can have per unit and the spacing requirements between those units. First, let's start with the language, and then we'll explain what this means. Adequate airflow is crucial, preventing overheating during operation. According to UL 9540 the separation between batteries should be 3ft (91. UL 9540 also provides that equipment evaluated to UL 9540A with a written report from a nationally recognized testing laboratory (NRTL), such as ETL, can be permitted to be installed with less than 3ft. less 9540A testing allows for closer spacing. ESS location requirements are detailed for areas including garages, accessory structures, utility closets, and outdoors. ESS installed outdoors may not be within 3-feet of doors and stored energy of 20 kWh per NFPA Section 15.
