

Tunisian schools use photovoltaic integrated energy storage cabinet automated models

Most Tunisian schools are cash-strapped and run down, but an innovative project has allowed one to become self-sustaining by generating its own solar power and growing its own food. This study reinforces the role of solar energy as a catalyst for a sustainable future by offering crucial information to educators, policymakers and entrepreneurs who want to match initiatives to install photovoltaic panels on Tunisian university roofs with sustainable development goals.
